M.D./M.S / P.G. DIPLOMA

MD/MS/P.G. Diploma (Broad Specialties) examinations are being scheduled from 26.07.2021.

MBBS

(i) Second and Third year Part-I, and Part-II

It is noted that for the candidates who are to take up the II MBBS and III MBBS Part I Examinations, all necessary procedures including filing of Internal Assessment and Attendance Particulars are complete.

However, in order to co-ordinate examination arrangements, availability of appropriate Clinical and Technical Material, services of faculty members and availability of Examiners, a period of three weeks may be permitted from the date of reopening of the colleges.

The examinations of II MBBS and III MBBS Part I Examinations will be conducted after three weeks from the date of re-opening of the colleges.

(ii) Supplementary examination of I MBBS
